Activities



Make time
to read to children every day.



Talk to children
about the pictures as you read the book.



Ask children questions
about the story and to predict what may happen next.



Read with expression,
changing your voice for different characters and situations.



Let children see you read
your own books, magazines or newspapers.



Help children choose
and check-out a variety of books at the library. Ask a librarian for help in finding books that are age-appropriate and interest them.



Read children's favorite books
over and over again. Children learn through repetition.



Make your home
a place where stories are shared.
